Ομιλήτρια η Ομότιμη Καθηγήτρια Rachel Lev-Wiesel, PhD. του Πανεπιστημίου της Haifa (School of Art therapy)

Rachel Lev-Wiesel, Ph.D. is a Professor in the Graduate School of Creative Arts Therapies at Haifa University, Israel. She is the chair of The Emili Sagol Research Center of Creative Arts Therapies, serves as the ombudswoman for sexual harassment prevention at the University of Haifa. She is a licensed family and group therapist, expert in treatment of sexual abused survivors. Her main research interests are: trauma, posttraumatic growth, child abuse, violence, and the use of drawings for diagnostic and therapeutic purposes. Specifically, she concentrates on the risk factors and consequences of child sexual abuse on individuals, their families, and the social environment. A central focus of her work is how people's drawings reveal personality characteristics, personal conflicts, and coping styles. Dr. Lev-Wiesel has developed therapeutic techniques in this area aimed at helping the working professional to identify and treat victims of child sexual abuse and people who suffer from dissociative disorders. She has published more than 160 peer-reviewed papers and chapters, as well as 8 books. Her last book, *When Time Stood Still* (2015), displays the healing process of a child sexual abuse survivor through art therapy.
